

RapidBIZ and Docker

Overview

RapidBIZ is delivered in a Docker container. The container contains, RapidBIZ, CentOS, & Open Liberty. A RapidBIZ Docker can then be linked to the desired, supported database¹. Additionally, applications developed with RapidBIZ can also be delivered via a Docker Container. RapidBIZ Docker Containers have been certified for IBM Cloud Paks -

Applications Built on RapidBIZ

Applications developed with RapidBIZ can also be delivered via a Docker Container. A typical Docker would contain RapidBIZ Runtime, CentOS, Open Liberty and the application(s). Like a RapidBIZ Docker, application containers can also be linked to the desired, supported database¹ – no matter what database the application was originally developed on.
